This product was designed and manufactured to meet strict quality and safety standards. There are, however, some installation and operation precautions which you should be particularly aware of.


- All the safety and operating instructions should be read before the product is operated and should be followed carefully.
- 2. All warnings in the operating instructions should be followed.
- The sets should not be used near water-for example, near a bathtub, wash-bowl, kitchen sink, laundry tub, in a wet basement, or near a swimming pool, etc.
- 4. The sets should be placed so that proper ventilation is ensured. For example, it should not be placed on a bed, sofa, rug or similar surface that may block the installation, such as a bookcase or through the ventilation openings.
- 5. The sets should not be placed close to heat sources such as radiators, stoves, or any other appliance that produces heat.

  - E. It has been dropped, or the housing has been damaged.






